Creating the Index:

The minimum score is 8 (1 point on each question above)

The maximum score is 24 (3 points on each question above)

Score between 8 and 13 = lower income individuals –

Score between 14 and 18 = middle class individuals – *disregarded*

Score between 19 and 24 = upper middle class individuals

Scores below 8 means that at least one question was not responded to.

If more than questions are not responded to, the screener is disregarded.

If one or two questions are not responded to, the following scoring applies.

Score between 6 and 9 = lower income individuals –

Score between 10 and 13 = middle class individuals – *disregarded*

Score between 14 and 18 = upper middle class individuals
